Electronic Fund Recurring Payment Authorization Form

You have the option to have your water/sewer bill automatically deducted from your checking or savings account each month. Just complete and sign this form and return it to our office at the above address to get started.

Recurring Payments Can Make Your Life Easier:

- It's convenient (saving you time and postage)
- Your payment is always on time (even if you're out of town), eliminating late charges

Here's How Recurring Payments Work:

You authorize monthly charges to your checking or savings account. You will be charged the **BALANCE** shown on your monthly bill card from RAE Water each month. If you have questions on the Balance shown you will need to contact RAE Water by the 15th of the month.

Your bill will still be mailed to you each month and will indicate "Account will be drafted." The charges will appear on your bank statement as an "ACH Debit." We will only be able to process the authorization form if you indicate whether it is checking or savings and provide the following information:
