About This Project:

The purpose of this project is to install sub-surface infiltration galleries to re-infiltrate treated water back to the ground. The main components of the project consist of a buried pipeline for conveyance of the reclaimed water, sub-surface infiltration gallery, and construction of a small control building.

The project has received funding in whole or in part from the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, and from the Montana Department of Environmental Quality State Revolving Fund Loan Assistance program for Wastewater Treatment Facilities.
